

































R ONE-WAY ROADWAY WITH SIDEWALK






ONE-WAY ROADWAY WITH BIKE LANE AND SIDEWALK

ONE-WAY ROADWAY WITH SHARED MULTI-USE TRAIL







Conservation Commission Inland Wetlands: 3 MONTHS

Planning Commission: 3 MONTHS

CT DEEP Individual Dam Safety: 12 MONTHS

Army Corps of Engineers General Permit #17 and a PCN: 18 MONTHS

State Historic Preservation Office: 1 MONTH

CT DOT Office of State Traffic Administration: 3 MONTHS

CT DEEP General Permit for Discharge of Stormwater: 2 MONTHS

CT DOT Encroachment Permit: 2 MONTHS
