Required Documentation

What if I can't find the Birth Certificate for my child?

• You can provide a Baptismal Certificate or School Verification or other document which identifies child's birth date and you as their parent or guardian. This could be a letter from the school or from church or from the health system.

What can be used as income verification?

• Applicants may provide pay stubs from wages and or a statement of benefits received from unemployment, social security, child support, DSS, or verification from a referring agency.

What can be used as proof of address?

• The easiest way to provide proof of address is with a piece of postmarked mail. However, applicants may provide proof of address via Property Tax Receipt, Utility Bills, Lease Agreement or mortgage statement, Insurance Card, Voter Registration Card, Education Enrollment Papers, Bank or credit card statement, or insurance policy or bill.
