



## SAFETY GUIDELINES

**Please read the below safety guidelines carefully.**

1. Use gloves to protect your hands from germs and injury.
2. Within your assigned group, pair-up; work in teams of 2-4.
3. Keep within sight or hearing range of other group members.
4. Be careful working near street or next to the curb.
5. Watch out for poison ivy, bees, and thorns. Avoid whenever possible.
6. Be watching for glass, sharp metal, and needles. Handle all sharp objects with caution.
7. If your bag gets heavy, start another.
8. Keep metal separate from other trash.
9. Sunscreen or hats are recommended to prevent sunburn.
10. See instructions below for trash pick up areas.

### TRASH PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS:

All trash bags should be securely tied and left at the roadside where they can be seen – the Bristol Department of Public Works will pick them up at the end of the day and throughout the week of April 25th.
