

SAFETY GUIDELINES

Please read the below safety guidelines carefully.

- 1. Use gloves to protect your hands from germs and injury.
- 2. Within your assigned group, pair-up; work in teams of 2-4.
- 3. Keep within sight or hearing range of other group members.
- 4. Be careful working near street or next to the curb.
- 5. Watch out for poison ivy, bees, and thorns. Avoid whenever possible.
- 6. Be watching for glass, sharp metal, and needles. Handle all sharp objects with caution.
- 7. If your bag gets heavy, start another.
- 8. Keep metal separate from other trash.
- 9. Sunscreen or hats are recommended to prevent sunburn.
- 10. See instructions below for trash pick up areas.

TRASH PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS:

All trash bags should be securely tied and left at the roadside where they can be seen – the Bristol Department of Public Works will pick them up at the end of the day and throughout the week of April 25th.
