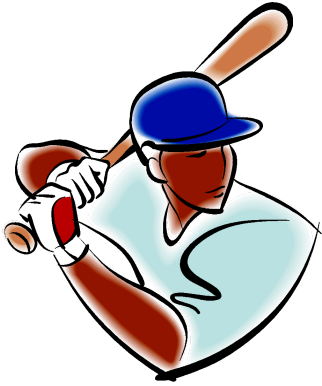




Pony League Baseball



Bristol Parks, Recreation, Youth and Community Services' Pony League Baseball program is for boys in grades 7th through 10th (at the time of registration). Pony

League will run from mid-June to mid-August, and teams will play 15+ regular-season games, and all teams make the playoffs. Teams will play two games a week and have at least one practice. Games are played on weekday evenings and occasionally during the day on weekends at local fields (Riley Field, Page Park, Muzzy Field). Team schedules will be handed out as soon as they become available. Contact League Director Shawn Mirmina at shawnmirmina@bristolct12.org if you have any questions.

Fee: Registration is \$75. The league will be capped at 84 players. All players who register after the cap is reached will be placed on a waiting list and are not guaranteed a spot on a team.

Please note: Players are not allowed to play in Pony League if they are participating in other Bristol-based baseball leagues, except Bristol Junior/Senior League. Players trying out for another Bristol-based or out-of-town summer league (i.e. American Legion, Junior Legion, AAU) must still register for Pony League to ensure a spot on a team. Players who make other leagues will receive a full refund for their Pony League registration.

Pony League "Try-Outs" will be held on **Saturday, June 7th** at Page Park. All **NEW** players to the league (of any age) are encouraged to attend. Players who have played Pony League in the past but did not play last season are also encouraged to attend. More information regarding tryouts will be sent out at a later date.
