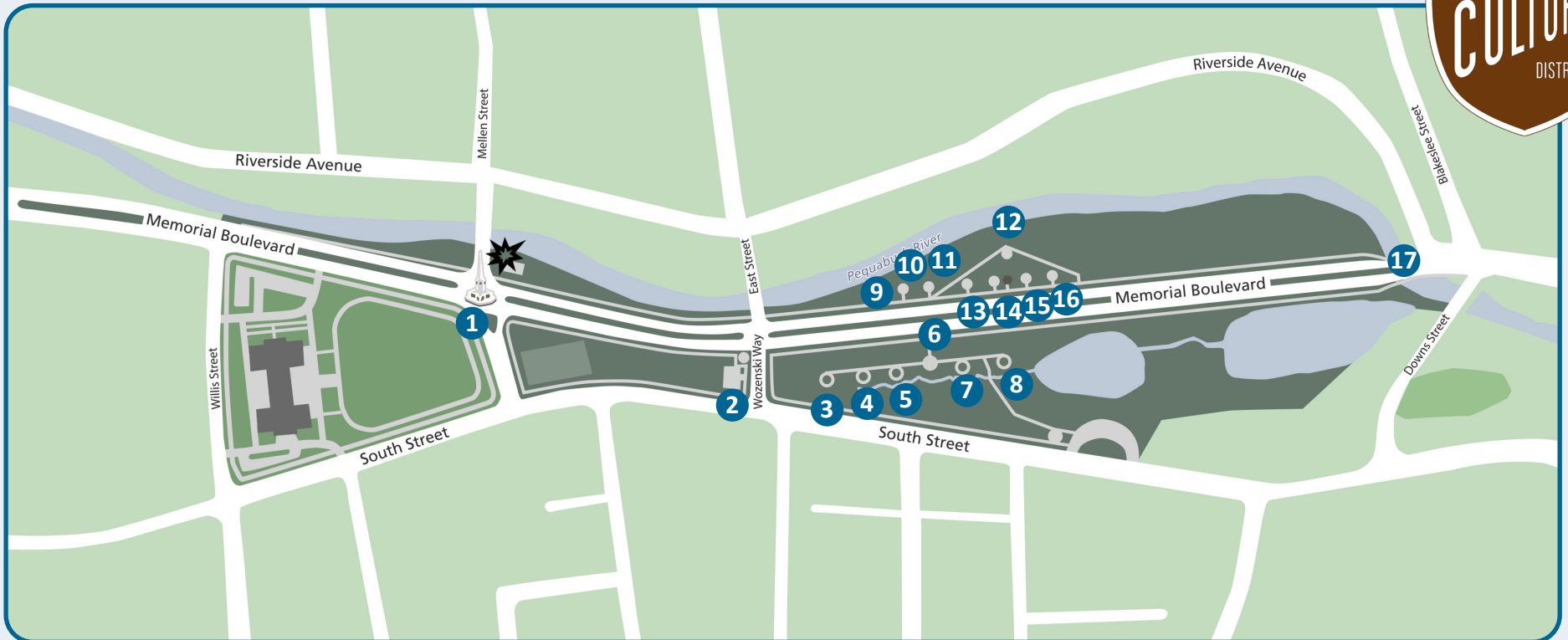

Veterans Memorial Boulevard

Welcome to Veterans Memorial Boulevard, a 25 acre park, which serves as the gateway to downtown Bristol and is a feature of the City's Cultural District. In partnership with CRIS Access, the Bristol Lions Club, and the Veterans Council, the City of Bristol's Department of Parks, Recreation, Youth and Community Services has developed an audible tour of the park. This tour highlights eleven of the park's monuments and includes recordings from local historians and Bristol veterans, detailing information about the park's history, the origins of the monuments, and stories of Bristol residents who served in the military during conflicts and wars. The audible tour can be accessed by downloading the CRIS ACCESS app or by scanning the QR code using your smartphone's camera app.

Bienvenido al Bulevar Conmemorativo de los Veteranos, un parque de 25 acres, que sirve como puerta de entrada al centro de Bristol y es una característica del Distrito Cultural de la Ciudad. En asociación con CRIS Access, el Club de Leones de Bristol y el Consejo de Veteranos, el Departamento de Parques, Recreación, Juventud y Servicios Comunitarios de la Ciudad de Bristol, se ha desarrollado un recorrido audible por el parque.
