Position Goal(s): To develop curriculum and administer classes to increase arts & culture class offerings for department customers of all ages.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for all operations of program including developing curriculum, identifying supplies and materials, supervising participants, and conducting class instruction.
- Represents the department by ensuring quality customer service and safety for all participants and families.
- Works collaboratively with the Arts & Culture Supervisor to develop class topics, schedules and efficient execution.
