Effective immediately masks will no longer be required in any City of Bristol Parks, Recreation, Youth & Community Services (BPRYCS) facilities, programs and office spaces regardless of a person's vaccination status. Anyone that would prefer to continue wearing masks are welcome to do so but we are unable to require guests to utilize masks. This change is aligned with the latest updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH), and the City of Bristol policies. As always policies are subject to change as pandemic conditions change.
