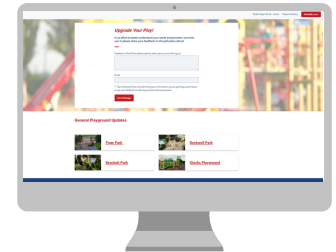

### VISIT THE PARKS PROJECT PORTAL

Due to the complex nature of projects and the unpredictability of the construction industry, project updates are very fluid and can change on a weekly basis. As a means to keep our residents informed we have created an interactive Park Projects Portal (PPP); accessible via [bristolct.myrec.com](http://bristolct.myrec.com). The PPP provides status reports and updates on all projects happening within the park system, project presentations and plans, and allows residents to provide comments and feedback on existing projects or recommendations for new projects.

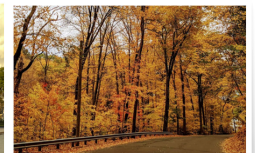


### PARK & FACILITY RENTALS

Bristol parks, fields and facilities can be reserved by residents and organizations. Requests for fields, pavilions, park spaces, and the showmobile can be made at [bristolct.myrec.com](http://bristolct.myrec.com). Click the "Facilities" tab and then select the facility/space you are seeking to reserve. Applicants must then log in or create an account in order to finalize the reservation request. Reservation requests are checked weekly by Parks Department staff. Proper insurance certificates and payment (when applicable) will be requested prior to a permit being issued.
