SEASONAL UPDATES

Pickleball & Tennis Courts

- Pickleball nets will remain up and courts will be open through the winter at Seymour Park (Shrub Rd.). Page Park tennis courts (651 King St.) will be open through March, pending revitalization construction. Courts at Peck Park will not be available and will be locked this winter.
- Players assume full risk and responsibility for determining safe court conditions.

Restrooms

- All outdoor bathrooms, irrigation, and splash pads are shut off/down and winterized for the season & will reopen in May.

Sledding

- Visit our popular sledding hill at Nelson Field (Corner of Burlington Ave. & Maple Ave.). Sledding at Page Park is not permitted due to ongoing construction.
- Please note sledding hill availability is subject to change depending on weather conditions. Sledgers assume full risk and responsibility for determining safe conditions.

Park Lights

- Bristol parks close at 10PM unless participating in a department sanctioned activity or issued a permit for after hours activity. Park, facility, and field lights operate on a timer in conjunction with scheduled activities and park hours.

PARKS PROJECT PORTAL

The Project Portal provides status reports and updates on major projects happening within the park system, project presentations and plans, and allows residents to provide comments and feedback on existing projects or recommendations for new projects.



• Page Park - Revitalization

- Phase I of the Page Park Revitalization project is underway and will take 18 months to complete. Project work will include a community great lawn, new playground, new splash pad, four lighted pickleball courts, a pickleball and tennis complex pavilion and shade structure, nearly 200 additional parking spaces, pedestrian walkways and sidewalks, and restoration of the Page Park Pond.

• Rockwell Park - Revitalization

- Bristol was recently awarded the \$1.9 million dollar matching grant from the Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership (ORLP). Renovations will include improvements to the Rockwell splash pad, playground, disc golf course, basketball courts and ADA upgrades to the trail system and Fraser Little League Field.

• Federal Hill Green - New Playground

- Federal Hill Green is getting a new playground and community members selected the design! The new playground features an impressive height of 18'9" and includes variety of climbing, sliding, and imaginative play elements. The playground is set to be installed in Spring 2025.

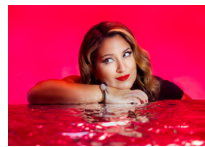
