SUMMARY: Responsible for guiding and ensuring the safety of children in our camps as they engage in various camp activities. Leads, supports, and motivates campers as they enjoy all that camp has to offer. This position will help plan activities, lead group events, and monitor campers to ensure a safe and positive environment.

GENERAL DUTIES: Assists with the daily operations of assigned summer camp, helping to ensure a safe, engaging, and memorable environment for all participants. Plans, facilitates, and leads group activities according to the camp week's theme. Monitors and ensures the safety and well-being of all campers, addressing concerns promptly and documenting and reporting incidents according to camp procedures. Communicates regularly with camp leadership regarding camper participation, behavior, and any notable observations. Attends scheduled field trips to chaperone and support participants, ensuring their safety and positive engagement throughout the day. Collaborates with other camp staff to create a welcoming, inclusive, and fun experience for all campers.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must be at least 15 years of age with reliable transportation. Requires the ability to successfully complete or hold American Red Cross CPR/First Aid Certification (training provided). Must have the ability to work with groups of various ages, gender, race, ethnicity and socio-economic background.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE: None required.

WORK SCHEDULE & CLASSIFICATION: The Recreation Leader position is seasonal and runs from June through August. Typically, 30-35 hours a week will be available, and work is generally conducted between 7:45 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Hours will be determined based on camp assignment and Before/After Care needs. A commitment to all seven weeks and a week of training beforehand is required. This position is non-benefitted.
