

# PICKLEBALL COURT USE RULES



**Did you know?** The City of Bristol Parks, Recreation, Youth and Community Services Department also has pickleball courts at Page Park (King St) & Peck Park (Daley St)!

## General Use Rules

- 1 Proper court etiquette & sportsmanship expected
- 2 Non-marking shoe required
- 3 Animals prohibited on the courts
- 4 Skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, skates & bicycles prohibited on the courts
- 5 All other applicable park rules and city ordinances apply

## Peak Use Rules

**In the event the pickleball courts are busy and all courts are occupied, the following rotation policies have been established:**

- 1 Waiting players place paddles in designated area in groups of up to four players
- 2 When a game is complete, the next players waiting rotate onto the court
- 3 The next players waiting move up to be next in line
- 4 If players wish to continue play, they go to the end of the line
- 5 Waiting players continue to move up the line as games finish
- 6 Court use is limited to standard game scoring format, first to 11 points, winning teams must win by 2

## Reservations

Courts are available on a first-come, first-served basis for public use. The Bristol Parks, Recreation, Youth and Community Services Department offers 2-hour rentals for a court on a limited basis subject to fees established by the Board of Park Commissioners. Individuals with reservations shall present a reservation permit issued by the department in the event of a dispute. The BPRYCS department reserves the right to reserve courts for recreational programming at its discretion.
